



## Te Rōhutu Whio

### Special Programme

#### **Te Poari Matua The Establishment Board of Te Rōhutu Whio has implemented a special programme amendment to our enrolment scheme effective from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022**

The school board of Te Rōhutu Whio operates the following special programme;

#### **Te Korowhio Reorua Hub**

and expects that there will be about “30” places available in the programme for out-of-zone students next year. Next year there will be four enrolment periods. The first enrolment period runs from 2<sup>nd</sup> February to 14<sup>th</sup> April 2022.

For students seeking enrolment within the first enrolment period, the deadline for receipt of applications for out-of-zone places is 4pm, 19th November 2021. Whānau will be informed of the outcome once all uiui interviews have been held, Monday 29th November 2021.

The criteria for acceptance into the Te Korowhio Reorua hub is as follows:

- All prospective learners will need to demonstrate a commitment to te reo Māori me ōna tikanga as observed by the Kaihautū Māori and the Te Korowhio Reorua Committee as well as Whānau having a strong commitment to using te reo Māori me ōna tikanga in the home.
- Entry is determined by our Kaihautū Māori and the Te Korowhio Reorua Committee who sit independently of the school.
- If there are more applicants than spaces available in the programme, places will be balloted according to the criteria set.
- The number of learners who are able to join Te Korowhio Reorua hub is limited to 60 places. (see note 1)
- For learners who meet the commitment above, priority for acceptance into the programme is in the following order:

1. Applicants residing within the Te Rōhutu Whio home zone and with siblings currently enrolled at our Reorua hub.
2. Applicants who reside within the Te Rōhutu Whio home zone.
3. Applicants from our contributing Kōhanga (see note 2)
4. Applicants residing outside of the Te Rōhutu Whio home zone and with siblings currently enrolled at our Reorua hub.
5. Applicants with extended whānau connections, for example, cousins.
6. All other applicants.

If there are more applicants in any priority group than places available, a ballot will be conducted.

- Priority will be given to those where Te Rōhutu Whio is their closest geographical Reorua provision.
- Note 1: The number for out of zone places will be determined following applications from in-zone students during the pre-enrolment process. Spaces available for out of zone learners will be published on the Te Rōhutu Whio website each year.
- Note 2: This priority is to allow future access for students that may attend a Kōhanga in Rolleston. Details relating to the second, third and fourth enrolment periods are as follows:

**Length of enrolment period:** Term 2 2022 – Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2022 – 8<sup>th</sup> July 2022

Deadline for receipt of applicants: 4pm Friday 11<sup>th</sup> March 2022

**Length of enrolment period:** Term 3 2022 – Monday 25<sup>th</sup> July 2022 – Friday 30<sup>th</sup> September 2022

Deadline for receipt of applicants: 4pm Friday 27<sup>th</sup> May 2022

**Length of enrolment period:** Term 4 2022 – Monday 17<sup>th</sup> October – Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December 2022

Deadline for receipt of applicants: 4pm Friday 26<sup>th</sup> August 2022
